



THE FIRST YEAR OF EUVHS PROJECT

EUVHS project has successfully reached its first years of activities!

The consortium has completed the development of project first resource 'Virtual Schooling Toolkit for school leadership teams and teachers' that is available for consultation and download in English, Greek, German, and Italian on the project website [here](#). Together with the Toolkit, partners have produced and published the Transnational Report based on the data collected through questionnaires and focus groups that have involved teachers and school leaders in partner countries and based on National desk researches. The Report presents an overview on digital education in secondary schools at European and National level focusing on the needs reported from teachers and school leaders to be addressed for a quality virtual learning.

HOW TO USE THE TOOLKIT

The Toolkit is a guide for school leader, teachers, learning designers, developers, researchers, support staff, to adopt a strategy for applying virtual schooling practices. It is divided into 4 sections:

1. Pedagogical framework on virtual schooling
2. Virtual Schooling readiness checklist
3. Best practices
4. Step-by-step guide on virtual schooling

The first section presents a detailed outline of strategies, guidelines, tips, and a concrete methodology that can be followed when teaching online, from the design to the actual delivery of the courses. The second section is thought for school leaders and teachers and is a checklist that measures the readiness of the schools and of the teachers to integrate virtual learning. Section 3 presents a collection of 30 best practices including tools, platforms, initiative, projects, and resources on digital education, while section 4 is a practical and simple guide for addressing virtual schooling, from curriculum alignment to health and well-being for teachers and learners. Section 2 and 4 are available in German, Greek, and Italian.

NEXT STEPS

In the coming months, partners will focus on the development of two resources, the Training course for school leadership teams, teachers, and staff and the Training course for students on how to be effective learners. The courses will be pilot tested from August to October 2022 by 20 teachers in every partner country that will then train their peers and their students ensuring the sustainability of the project. The courses will be freely accessible from next year on the EUVHS eLearning platform.

PARTNERS MEETINGS

Partners have met online in April to discuss on the development of the two training courses and to discuss about the coming Transnational Partners Meeting in June in which partners will peer assess the developed training courses. The Transnational Partners Meeting will take place in Athens and partners will also have the chance to discuss on the eLearning platform development.
